What You Need to Know about Overdrafts and Overdraft Fees

An <u>overdraft</u> occurs when you do not have enough money in your account to cover a transaction. We may pay the overdraft anyway. We handle your overdrafts in two different ways:

- 1. We have overdraft courtesy practices that come with your account.
- 2. We also offer <u>overdraft protection plans</u>, such as a link to a savings account, which may be less expensive than our <u>overdraft courtesy practices</u>. To learn more, ask us about these plans.

This notice explains our overdraft courtesy practices

What are the <u>overdraft courtesy practices</u> that apply to my account?

We do authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:

- Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number
- Automatic bill payments

We <u>do not</u> authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions unless you ask us to (see below):

- ATM Transactions
- Everyday debit card transactions

We pay overdrafts at our discretion, which means we <u>do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction. If we do <u>not</u> authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

What fees will I be charged if First Choice Credit Union pays my overdraft? Under our overdraft courtesy practices:

• We will charge you a fee of up to \$15.00 each time we pay an overdraft.
